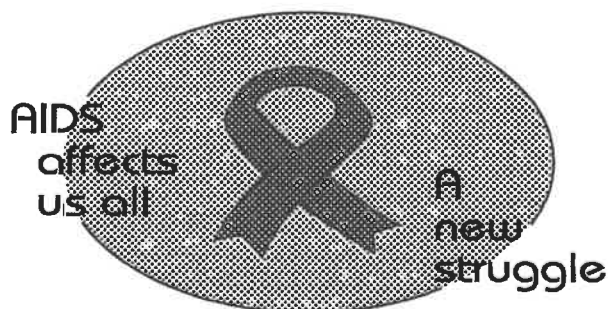

INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT: DRAFT KWAZULU-NATAL COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (2023-2028)

1. I, Siboniso Duma, Member of the Executive Council (MEC) responsible for Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal, acting in terms of section 46(1)(b) and (c) of the National Environmental Management: Integrated Coastal Management Amendment Act, 2014 (Act No. 36 of 2014), give notice to publish in the *Provincial Gazette* the Draft KwaZulu-Natal Coastal Management Programme (KZN CMP 2023-2028).
2. A provincial coastal management programme (PCMP) must be reviewed at least once every five years and may be amended when necessary.
3. Comments are hereby invited from the public before the KZN CMP 2023-2028 is adopted.
4. After all representations and objections from the public have been considered, the review will be completed, and the Draft KZN CMP 2023-2028 will be finalised and submitted to the MEC for adoption under section 46(1) of the Act.
