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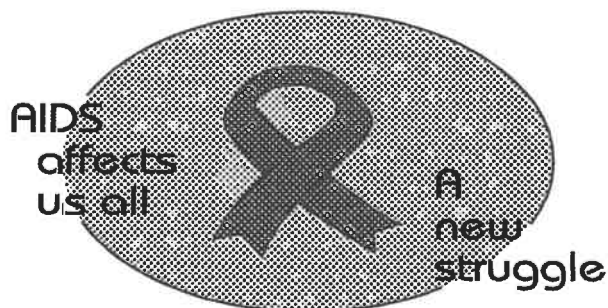

FOR COMMENT: DRAFT ESTUARINE MANAGEMENT PLANS FOR KWAZULU-NATAL

I, Siboniso Duma, the Member of the Executive Council (MEC) for the Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs, hereby invite members of the public to comment on the drafts of the following Estuarine Management Plans (EMP) developed in terms of section 34(1)(a) read with section 53(1)(c) of the National Environmental Management: Integrated Coastal Management Act, 2008 (Act No. 24 of 2008):

- a) iKongeni Estuary Management Plan;
- b) uThongathi Estuary Management Plan;
- c) iLovu Estuary Management Plan;
- d) iZinkwazi Estuary Management Plan and
- e) aMahlongwa Estuary Management Plan.

EMP's are an integrated management planning tool used to understand the ecological health conditions, conservation and biodiversity aspects, and key pressures on estuaries. Its primary intention is to coordinate the implementation of the identified key actions to improve an estuary's ecological health status and ensure goods and services are maintained to support socio-economic benefits. These plans have identified various threats such as deterioration of water quality, sand mining, estuary mouth dynamics, exploitation of resources and loss of habitat. The EMP's seek to facilitate cooperative management amongst key sector departments and relevant stakeholders through the implementation of a shared vision and objectives of these plans to improve the health status of the respective estuaries.

Members of the public are invited to submit written representations or objections on the draft EMP's, within 30 (thirty) days after the publication of this notice in the *Gazette*. Written representations on or objections to the draft EMP's received after this time may not be considered. All representations and comments must be submitted in writing to the Head of Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs.
